Friday will be test and tune: pit gate opens at 3 p.m. (\$20 pit pass); testing begins at 4 p.m. with FREE grandstands.

Saturday fun activities will begin at noon and continue until 3 p.m. These activities include a car show; motorcycle and automotive swap meet; pit crew challenge; ride in a race car; live music and much, much more.

While there, also plan to visit the Ag and Performance Motorsports Museum located on the grounds. It features many restored cars including the #98 owned by the Holt family and driven by Ron Holt for many years.

The pits will open at 3 p.m. with a drivers meeting at 4:30p.m. Admission for Grandstands:\$20.00 for Adults and 15.00 Military (must show military ID or other proof of service at park check-in). Children 8 years old and under get in free with the purchase of an adult ticket.

Pit Passes will be \$30 for adults (Military \$25) and bike registration \$50. Hot laps will begin at 5 p.m. for vintage cars and flat track motorcycles. Racing will follow.
